REVISED SAFETY RULES FOR SILVER RUN LAKES

It is in the interest of all members, owners and guest to work together by following, with courtesy and caution, each of the following rules:

1. ALL PROPERTY OWNERS SHALL INFORM EACH MEMBER OF THEIR FAMILY AND GUEST OF THESE SAFETY RULES AND BE RESPONSIBLE THEREOF AND ISSUE A VISITOR PASS TO BE KEPT WITH THEM AT ALL TIMES(BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE MEMBERSHIP – SRLPO, SEPTEMBER 6, 1998)
2. THE ENFORCEMENT OF THESE RULES SHALL BE BORNE BY THE PROPERTY OWNERS AND IN THE EVENT OF A VIOLATION A VERBAL WARNING SHALL BE GIVEN TO THE PROPERTY OWNER. IF THE SAME VIOLATION IS REPEATED, IT WILL BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE BOARD MEMBERS TO NOTIFY THE RESPONSIBLE PROPERTY OWNER BY LETTER. UPON THE THIRD VIOLATION OF THE SAME RULE A ONE HUNDRED DOLLAR FINE WILL BE IMPOSED. (THE PROPERTY OWNER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR GUEST AND WILL BE HELD ACCOUNTABLE) (BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE MEMBERSHIP – SRLPO, SEPTEMBER 6, 1998.)
3. FIREARMS – THERE SHALL BE NO SHOOTING OF GUNS WITHIN THE SUBDIVISION, WITH THE SINGULAR EXCEPTION FOR THE ELIMINATION OF UNWANTED PESTS. IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT THE PERSON FIRING SUCH GUN SHALL ASSUME THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY ACCIDENTS OR DAMAGE.
4. MOTORBIKES AND EXTRA TERRAIN VEHICLES – THE OPERATION OF THESE VEHICLES SHALL BE RESTRICTED TO THE PUBLIC ROADS WITHIN THE SUBDIVISION. THEY SHALL NOT BE OPERATED IN A RECKLESS MANNER AND SPEED SHALL NOT EXCEED 25 MILES PER HOUR. OPERATION OF SUCH VEHICLES DURING HOURS OF DARKNESS SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED.
5. OPEN FIRES – THE BURNING OF LEAVES AND TRASH SHOULD BE DONE WITH EXTREME CAUTION. A WATER HOSE SHOULD BE NEARBY AND NO BURNING SHOULD BE DONE IN HIGH WINDS OR WHEN A BURNING BAN HAS BEEN IMPOSED BY COUNTY AUTHORITIES. NO FIRE SHALL BE LEFT UNATTENDED AS SUCH PERSONS BURNING WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED BY AN UNCONTROLLED FIRE.
6. FIREWORKS – EXTREME CAUTION SHOULD BE EXERCISED IN FIREWORKS DISPLAYS ESPECIALLY DURING PERIODS OF DRY WEATHER.
7. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT EACH HOUSE HAVE AT LEAST ONE FIRE EXTINGUISHER AVAILABLE AT ALL TIMES AND KEEP A GARDEN HOSE CONNECTED AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT DURING PERIODS OF FREEZING WEATHER.
8. LAKE RULES – ALL MISSISSIPPI BOAT AND WATER SAFETY RULES APPLY ON SILVER RUN LAKES IN ADDITION TO THOSE IMPOSED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SRLPO.
9. ALL BOATS SHALL DISPLAY A SILVER RUN LAKES DECAL WITH THE EXCEPTION OF AUTHORIZED GUESTS OF PROPERTY OWNERS.
10. NO JET PROPULSION EQUIPMENT INCLUDING BOATS, SKIES AND PERSONAL WATER -CRAFT SHALL BE PERMITTED TO USE SILVER RUN LAKES. (BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE MEMBERSHIP – SRLPO, SEPTEMBER 1, 1996.)
11. SKIING HOURS SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE HOURS FROM 10:00 A. M. TO 6:00 P. M. EVERY DAY. ALL BOATS SHALL OBSERVE THAT LATE EVENING AND EARLY MORNING HOURS ARE RESERVED FOR FISHING. ALL BOATS WILL OBSERVE TROLLING SPEEDS DURING THESE TIMES REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OR NOT ANYONE IS FISHING ON THE LAKE.

12. DURING HOURS OF SKIING (10:00 A. M. TO 6: 00 P. M.) ALL POWERED MOTOR BOATS SHALL TRAVEL IN A COUNTER CLOCKWISE DIRECTION AND REMAIN AT LEAST 75 FT. FROM ALL DOCKS, PIERS, SWIMMING AREAS AND OTHER PERMANENT STRUCTURES. (THIS INCLUDES SKIERS AND OTHER TOWED DEVICES).
13. SAILBOATS SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT-OF-WAY AT ALL TIMES.
14. EXTREME CAUTION SHOULD BE EXERCISED IN SWIMMING AREAS AND POWERBOAT OPERATORS SHOULD BE AWARE OF SWIMMERS IN THEIR AREA.
15. ALL BOATING AND SWIMMING SHOULD CEASE DURING PERIODS OF LIGHTNING AND THUNDERSTORMS.
16. EACH PROPERTY OWNER WILL BE LIMITED TO ONE BOAT ON THE LAKE FOR SKIING.
17. EACH PERSON OPERATING A SKI BOAT SHALL HAVE A VALID DRIVING LICENSE AND HAVE ON BOARD AS AN OBSERVER ONE ADDITIONAL PERSON WITH A VALID DRIVERS LICENSE. BY UNANIMOUS VOTE BY THE MEMBERSHIP – 11 OCTOBER 2009)
18. ALL NON-SWIMMERS AND CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 10 YEARS MUST WEAR AN APPROVED FLOATATION DEVICE. SUCH DEVICES ARE REQUIRED TO BE ON BOARD FOR EACH OCCUPANT.
19. ALL POWERBOATS OPERATING DURING PERIODS OF DARKNESS MUST UTILIZE COAST GUARD APPROVED LIGHTING.
20. THE MAXIMUM SPEED FOR ALL POWERBOATS ON SILVER RUN LAKE IS 25 MILE PER HOUR. (BY UNANIMOUS VOTE BY THE MEMBERSHIP – 11 OCTOBER 2009)
21. CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES IN THE DESIGNATED SWIMMING AREA. (BY UNANIMOUS VOTE BY THE MEMBERSHIP – 6 SEPTEMBER 1998)
22. TROUT LINES, DROP LINES, YO-YO'S, JUG AND BUOY FISHING, NETTING AND FISH TRAPS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN ANY LAKE MAINTAINED BY SILVER RUN PROPERTY OWNERS ASS'N., INC. ALL SPORT FISHING EQUIPMENT MUST BE WATCHED AT ALL TIMES TO INSURE BOATS, SKIERS AND SWIMMERS CANNOT GET ENTANGLED IN THE LINES. (BY UNANIMOUS VOTE BY THE MEMBERSHIP – 6 SEPTEMBER 1998)
23. DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH WHEN ALLOWED OUTDOORS. THEY MAY BE OFF LEASH IF THE OWNER IS PRESENT AND IN CONTROL OF THE ANIMAL. (BY UNANIMOUS VOTE BY MEMBERSHIP – SEPTEMBER 2001)
24. KENNELS SHALL BE LOCATED AT LEAST FIFTY FEET BACK FROM THE WATER'S EDGE SO AS TO PREVENT POSSIBLE BACTERIAL CONTAMINATION OF THE LAKE WATER. (BY UNANIMOUS VOTE BY MEMBERSHIP – SEPTEMBER 2001)
25. EXCESSIVE NOISE SUFFICIENT TO DISTURB THE TRANQUILITY OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD WILL NOT BE PERMITTED. IF THE PROPERTY OWNER FAILS, REFUSES OR NEGLECTS TO TAKE THE NECESSARY STEPS TO REMEDY THIS PROBLEM, THE STONE COUNTY SHERIFF DEPARTMENT MAY BE CONTACTED. (BY UNANIMOUS VOTE BY MEMBERSHIP – SEPTEMBER 2001)
26. BREEDING OF PETS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED. (BY UNANIMOUS VOTE BY MEMBERSHIP – SEPTEMBER 2001)

THE SAFETY COMMITTEE SOLICITS THE COOPERATION OF ALL MEMBERS AND TRUSTS THAT THE YEAR WILL BE ONE OF PLEASURE AND SAFETY.
